Bavaria owes much of its economic success to a highly qualified workforce with a world-class vocational and academic education. Public funding for education is substantial. It exceeded 150 million Euros alone for vocational education and further training within the past 5 years (2013-2017).

The rising demand for qualified personnel represents one of the biggest challenges that companies from all industrialised nations will face in the near future, with demographic change and globalisation which will affect Bavaria as well. However, Bavarian companies profit from a wide range of locational advantages in the competition for bright minds:
