- Tobias Gotthardt was born on June 3, 1977 in Regensburg and grew up in Burglen-genfeld and Kallmünz.
- After completing his high school education and studying political science in Regensburg and Freiburg, he initially worked as a parliamentary assistant and head of office in the European Parliament and the German Bundestag.
- After his election to the Bavarian State Parliament in 2018, he assumed the chair-manship of the Committee for Federal and European Affairs. In addition, in 2021, he was appointed as deputy and then acting chairman of the Committee of Educa-tion and Culture. At the same time, he was the federal, European, education and youth policy spokesman of the FREIE WÄHLER parliamentary group.
- After his re-election, Tobias Gotthardt was appointed Vice Minister and member of the Bavarian State Government in 2023.
